YTBN Update: This Sunday (Feb. 19th) from 7:00-8:30 pm, we meet at St. James on Paris St. to hear from Laurie Racine, from the Sudbury CNIB. Laurie’s life-story is astonishing: she is a teacher, a mother of several kids and is also blind. Her humour, courage and honesty will leave you with a new definition of what it means to be blind. Laurie is a teacher at the CNIB office in Sudbury, and works with people who have recently experienced vision loss through macular degeneration or other illness. Mission and Outreach Lunch and Learn: Plan to stay after service for our first Lunch and Learn of 2012. Our own Monique Pilkington will speak on her outreach project with the CNIB mobile eye van which celebrates its 40th anniversary in 2012. This traveling ophthalmology clinic brings critical eye care services to 30 remote communities in Northern Ontario between March and November each year. A team of two CNIB Ophthalmic Assistants and 25 Ophthalmologists provide eye examinations, minor surgery and treatments for over 5,000 patients annually. Many of the conditions diagnosed and treated on the Eye Van would lead to permanent vision loss if left undetected. This critical service prevents blindness in our northern communities.
