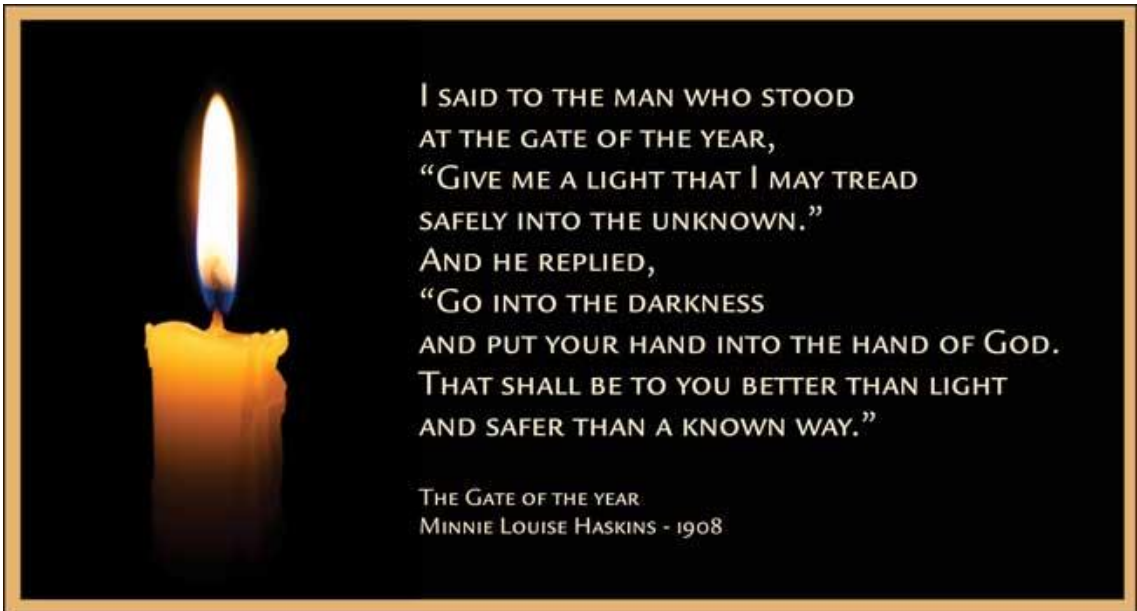

RECESSIONAL HYMN # 321 *All Hail the Power of Jesus' Name*

THE FEAST OF THE HOLY NAMES OF JESUS has been celebrated since the end of the fifteenth century. The celebration has been held usually on January 1st, because eight days after [Christmas](#), commemorates the naming of the child [Jesus](#); as recounted in the [Gospel](#) read on this day, *"at the end of eight days, when he was circumcised, he was called Jesus, the name given by the angel before he was conceived in the womb"*. The name "Jesus" is from the Hebrew Joshua, or Yehoshuah, "Yahweh is salvation" or "Yahweh will save." Devotion to the Holy Name of Jesus is particularly derived from Phil 2:9-11, which states that God highly exalted Jesus *"and gave him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bend, in heaven and on earth and under the earth."*
