

ALSO THIS SUNDAY - LUNCH & LEARN following 10:30 service. Our speaker will be Dr. Mike Franklyn who will share with us something of the Opioid crisis in Sudbury and elsewhere and the efforts to combat it.

WE EXTEND CONGRATULATIONS to our Bishop Anne Germond who this Sunday observes the first anniversary of her Consecration as Bishop. +Anne returns home tomorrow from a week in Canterbury, England where she joined over thirty other Bishops from around the Anglican Communion at the annual school for new Bishops. We pray that +Anne will be blessed and be a blessing for many years to come.

IN LENT THIS YEAR we will be using the modern version of the Scriptures from "The Message" by Eugene Peterson. We are making this move to provide a different way of hearing the Bible. The idea of "The Message" is to put the ancient words of the Bible into words that we today speak and write every day. The author, Eugene Peterson, a scholar and pastor, translated the words from Hebrew and Greek into this modern interpretation, to get the Bible back to everyday, common language. Following Lent we would like to hear your opinions. Hopefully we will continue using the version once monthly.

FOLLOWING OUR ASH WEDNESDAY service a new Lenten Bible study will begin entitled "Followers of Jesus". The studies look at New Testament characters who encountered Jesus at a point in their lives, either through curiosity or need, and the effect that encounter had upon their lives.

A LENTEN PILGRIMAGE: a 6-week journey into deeper intimacy with God encouraged to all by Bishop Anne Germond. "Meeting Jesus in the Gospel of John", created by the brothers of the Society of St. John the Evangelist (Cowley Fathers).
