**The season of Lent is upon us...** traditionally marked by self-examination, fasting and preparation for Easter. It is a time when Christians reflect on the biblical account of Jesus in the wilderness.

To assist in this holy season we at the Epiphany are presenting two weekly opportunities of study, Sunday mornings between services and Wednesday mornings following our mid-week Eucharist. Liturgically, the church is covered in purple, a sign of penitence. We also veil the crosses to underline the penitential character of Lent. The Lenten veils function something like sackcloth and ashes, symbols of mourning and penance. For the most part the sacrament of baptism does not take place, flowers are not placed in the Chancel and portions of the liturgy such as the "Gloria" are not sung. All of us are invited to the "observance of a Holy Lent".

**THE KING'S BUSINESS...** We are bringing back this weekly reminder of our Christian stewardship...an ongoing reflection of the part we are playing as "Christian stewards" serving in "the King's (Jesus') household.
