## READINGS FOR THE SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT: Genesis 15: 1-12, 17-18; Psalm 27;

Philippians 3:17-4:1; Luke 13:31-35

**QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION ON THE GOSPEL:** How does the image of a mother hen gathering her chicks under her wings in verse 34 resonate with you? What does it suggest about Jesus's love and desire for people?

In what ways do you see your own life mirroring the people of Jerusalem in this passage? Are there areas where you have been unwilling to follow Jesus's guidance?

**AT HOME PRAYERS: Morning** – Lord, as I begin this day, I thank you for your love and mercy. Help me to live in your grace and to follow your teachings. May my actions and thoughts be pleasing to you. Grant me the strength to make sacrifices and to grow closer to you during this Lenten journey. Amen

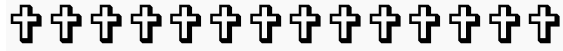
