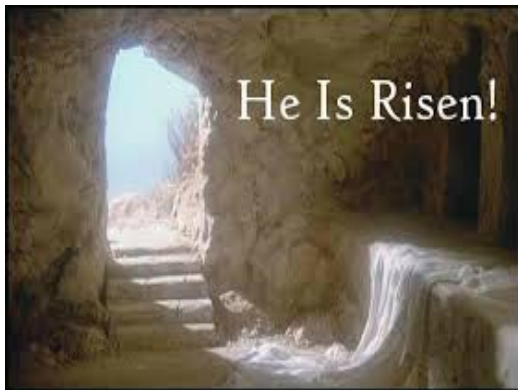

## *From the Desk of our Archdeacon*

### **A Reflection for Easter Weekend**

The Collect used for Good Friday reads, “Almighty God, look graciously, we pray, on this your family, for whom our Lord Jesus Christ was betrayed and given into the hands of sinners, and to suffer death upon the cross; who now lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever.”

A book titled “The Collects of Thomas Cranmer” contains the following observation on the prayer quoted above. ‘The prayer is disarming. It is for just one thing: for God to ‘look graciously, we pray, on this your family’. Look on us! Draw your attention to us as we rehearse this drama in two acts, the memory of the vivid power of to indispensable acts which took place on our behalf. Help us, O God, to enter into this.’ (C Frederick Barbee and Paul F. M. Zahl)

Throughout this drama-filled week we are invited to allow ourselves to feel the shame, pain, and grief that the first disciples experienced along with the ecstasy, bewilderment, and joy they experienced a few days later. Through these events God has announced that the risen Jesus is at the center of God’s plan for the salvation of the world. May we be blessed with a renewed understanding of the grace of God in the midst of our own suffering and struggles.

Since February 28, the escalating military violence in the Middle East has been worsening and widening, with humanitarian needs rising rapidly:

- More than 2,000 people have been killed, and more than 20,000 people are injured.
- Nearly 4 million people are internally displaced. In Lebanon alone, more than 810,000 people, including 290,000 children, have been forced to flee their homes.
- Hostilities have affected 14 countries so far, destroying or damaging schools, hospitals, health centres and energy infrastructure.

The Humanitarian Coalition (HC) is raising funds to rush life-saving assistance to people in need in Lebanon, Syria and across the wider region. The HC comprises 12 leading international aid organizations in Canada including the Canadian Foodgrains Bank. As a member of the Foodgrains Bank, Alongside Hope is able to participate in emergency fundraising appeals.
